### **Paul Lieder Hanson**

Paul L. Hanson, 91, of Northfield, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family, on Friday afternoon, February 23, 2024, at Three Links Care Center in Northfield.

Paul Lieder Hanson was born October 16, 1932, in Faribault, Minnesota, to Robert L. and Myrtle Ann (Lieder) Hanson. He was raised in rural Rice County and the Nerstrand area. In 1950, Paul graduated from Kenyon High School and attended Dunwoody Institute with a degree in carpentry. Paul and Barbara Mensing were married on July 10, 1953, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Faribault. In April 1953, Paul was inducted into the US Army and served during the Korean Conflict. Following his Honorable Discharge in April 1955 as Sergeant, they returned to the Northfield area. In 1962, he founded Paul L. Hanson Construction, Inc.

Paul was a member of Northfield United Methodist Church and the Northfield Golf Club. He is a former member of the Northfield Planning Commission and a former Bank Board Director of Frandsen Bank (formerly Dundas State Bank).
