We remember the hymns, the prayers, the meals, the movements—every act of love done in Christ's name.

Now, in this sanctuary shaped by Spirit and design, we gather to renew our calling as companions in Christ—mindful of the past, and open to the future.

All: Open our hearts, O God, to your presence among us. Stir our memory. Expand our vision. Ready our hands for service and our spirits for love. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
