It was written by Julia Ward Howe in 1861 and first published in February 1862, based on the tune of "John Brown's Body". It gained popularity among Union soldiers and became a symbol of the Union cause. The song's lyrics, filled with religious imagery and themes of justice and freedom, resonated with those fighting for the preservation of the Union and abolition of slavery.
